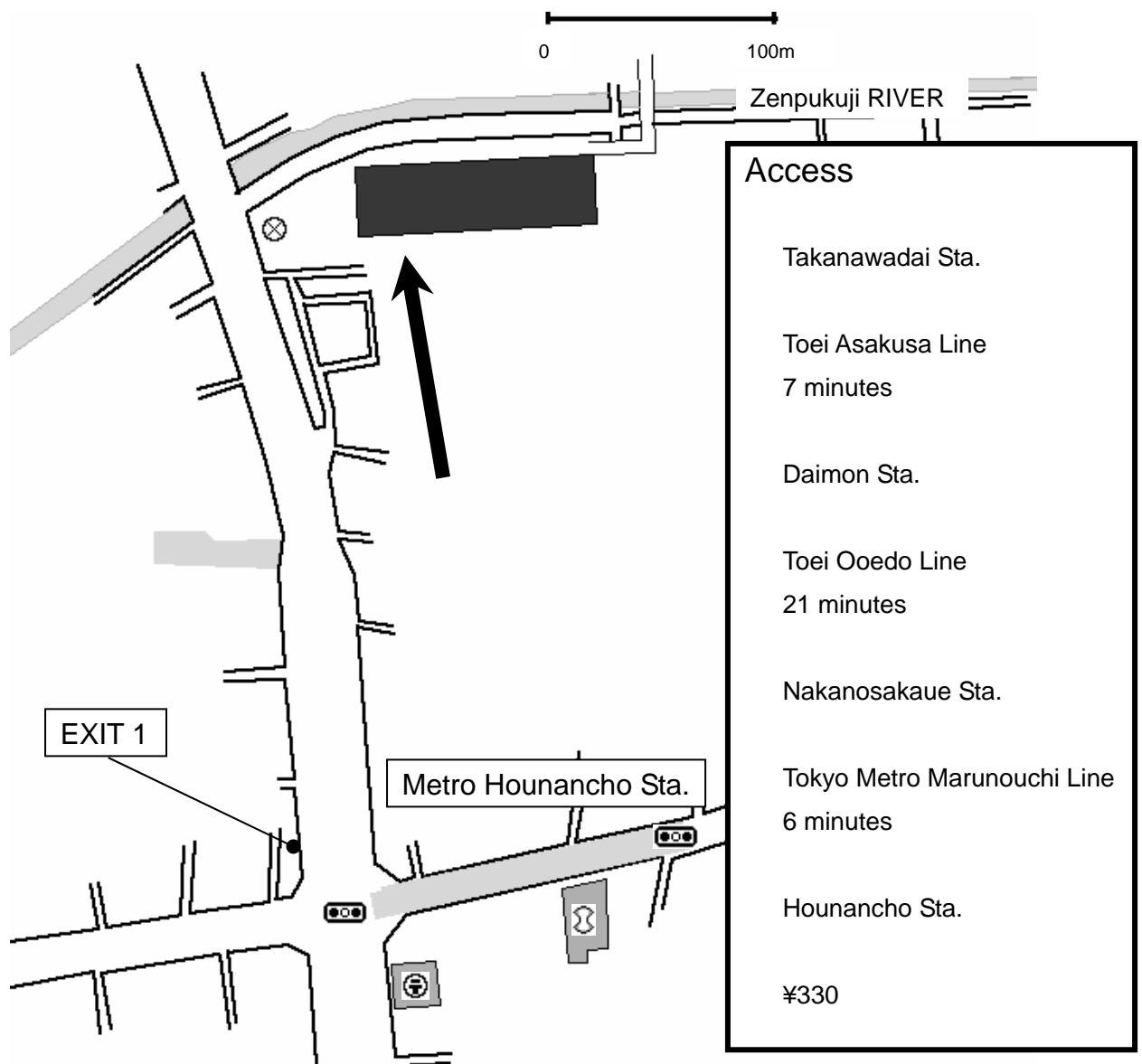

Notes

1. Please understand that this facility is used as a lodging facility by members of our organization when undertaking religious training at our headquarters. We ask that you kindly note the following while lodging with us:

(1) We do not have fulltime staff members who are conversant in foreign languages. We will do our best to help, but we ask that you understand that we may not always be able to meet your requests.

(2) The main gate to the facility closes at 22:00 (10:00 PM) and reopens at 5 AM. Please be aware that you will not be able to enter the facility after the gate has closed.

(3) Shower facilities are to be shared by all lodgers and are open 24-hours a day. We will draw water in the large Japanese bath if there is a significant number of lodgers. It can generally be used between 16-22:00 PM (4-10:00 PM).

(4) Please use the communal wash basins for washing your face, shaving, and brushing your teeth.

(5) Soap and shampoo is provided in the shower room and in the large bath. Bath towels are also available. All other shower/bath amenities must be provided by lodgers.

(6) We do not have FAX or Internet services. Each room is equipped with an internal phone line and there is a public phone in the lobby which can be hooked up to a modem.

(7) This facility is a non-smoking facility. Please smoke only in designated smoking areas.

(8) We ask that you leave and pick up your room key at the front desk upon exiting and entering the facility. Also, although each room is equipped with a lock, we ask that you take special care in protecting any valuables that you may have. We are not responsible for the loss, damage, or destruction of any personal property.

(9) Please make your own beds.

(10) We ask that you kindly return the room to a similar condition as to which you found it in before checkout.

2. Meals are as follows:

(1) A buffet service will be provided in the cafeteria on the night of the 26th, the morning of the 27th, the morning of the 28th, the night of the 29th, and the morning of the 30th. Breakfast is 330 Yen and dinner is 700 Yen per person. Please inform us if you intend to take part in the service well beforehand.


(2) Breakfast consists primarily of rice balls (onigiri) with various fillings and sandwiches.


(3) There is also a cafeteria in the facility next door. Ala carte breakfasts can be eaten here. It is not necessary to make reservations.


(4) We cannot provide vegetarian meals.


(5) Please note that there are also many other places where you can eat in the nearby Marunouchi Subway Station (Minami-Cho Station).
