

**Call for applications for the 8th Summer Program (2022)
of the Faculty of Letters of the University of Tokyo,
run from Wednesday 14th to Thursday 22nd September 2022**

The undergraduate students participating in the program will travel to Hokkaido, stay in the Fieldwork Station of the Faculty of Letters of the University of Tokyo (in Kitami), and learn about local cultures, history and heritage.

- The program is led by the Faculty of Letters of the University of Tokyo.
- Activities carried out in the program: visits to museums and heritage sites; participation in lectures, seminars and hands-on activities; international communication between students.
- The lectures and seminars are offered in English.
- The costs of travel including return flight tickets between Tokyo and Hokkaido, accommodation, meals and visits to museums and heritage sites are covered by the Faculty of Letters of the University of Tokyo.
- Number of participants: approx. 10 (approx. 5 Japanese undergraduate students and approx. 5 international undergraduate students)
- Application submission period: Monday 25th April to 12pm Tuesday 31st May 2022
- How to apply: see details on the website of the Faculty of Letters of the University of Tokyo
- Only undergraduate students of the University of Tokyo, regardless of the Faculty, Department, Program in which they study, can apply. Successful applicants must attend the entire program.
- The program may be cancelled in case the COVID restrictions are tightened.
